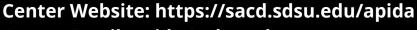

Congratulations to Student Success Fee grant recipients!

Woohoo! Congrats to our amazing student leaders who secured <u>Student Success Fee</u> funding for their amazing projects!

- Gi Gonzales got a \$10,590 grant to fund an educational field trip to Manzanar National Historic
 Site. This will be in conjunction with APIDA Center's common reading experience about the
 Japanese American Incarceration. Gi also got a \$7500 grant to fund the second annual APIDA
 Conference.
- Nadia Hernandez Ruelas got a \$8100 grant to fund an educational field trip to the <u>Museum of Tolerance</u> and the <u>Japanese American National Museum</u> in Los Angelos. Nadia also got a \$7500 grant to fund the third annual AFE (Allies For Education) 101 Conference, which is a professional development conference for teachers and teacher candidates.
- Leiana Lepule got a \$7500 grant to fund the second annual APIDA Hometown Heroes speaker series
- Krishna Ramamoorthy got a \$7000 grant to fund a hands-on conference about games and gaming.
- Alexa Lawrence got a \$5000 grant to fund the second annual STEM Education in Action series.
 Alexa also got a \$4000 grant to fund the second annual March Mindful Mondays with APIDA Crafts series.

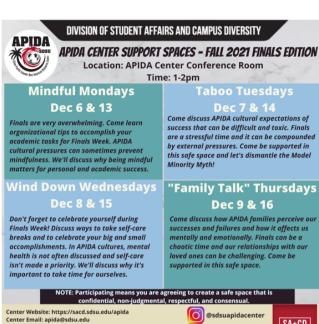

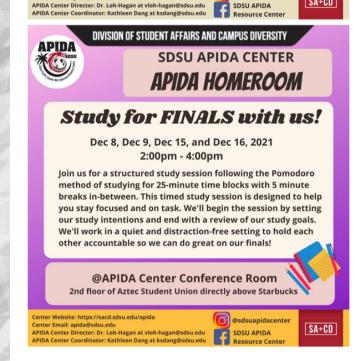
