You can only accept Venmo, credit cards, or checks. No cash. Some examples of products: Artwork, Sewing projects, Clothes you have designed and/or upcycled, Woodwork, Jewelry, Plant arrangements, Handmade cards, Fiber arts, Soaps, Pottery/Ceramics, Stickers, Caricatures, anything you make with your hands!

RULES FOR SINGERS/SONGWRITERS: You can only sing songs you have written. (The songs must not be offensive to women, people of color, etc.) You can sing no more than three songs in your set. You will be provided a microphone, chair, and speakers. Bring your own instruments. (Think coffeehouse open mic vibe!) You can sell your CDs, etc. You can only accept Venmo, credit cards, or checks. No cash.
